Message from Sr. Warden Chuck Critchfield

on behalf of the Vestry September 26, 2017

Fellow Parishioners:

I am pleased to announce that Rev. Nora Becker has officially accepted the call of the Vestry to be our rector.

Upon the completion of Nora's first year with us, the Vestry, Bishop Klusmeyer and Nora met in August to give Nora our feedback as part of the annual mutual ministry review. After that process the Vestry met and in a unanimous vote of the members present, decided to ask the Bishop permission to elect Nora as rector -- which he quickly granted. We completed the process of finalizing the Letter of Agreement with Nora last week and it is now official. So please welcome her as our rector!!

The text of the actual motion from the Vestry meeting is as follows: We move that the Vestry of Christ Church, on behalf of the congregation, request permission from Bishop Klusmeyer to elect Rev. Nora Becker to the rectorship of the parish of Christ Church Clarksburg/St. Barnabas Chapel with the following stipulation: Rev. Becker must continue to work with Rector's Reflectionary Group on a regular basis as directed and guided by the Vestry for a period of at least one year.

What followed that motion was a discussion about our role as parishioners in the work of the church. We felt that once Nora came on board last summer we relaxed. So the following pledge was approved: We the Vestry of Christ Episcopal Church and St Barnabas Chapel in our call to the Rev Nora Becker as rector, pledge to support her and call upon the parish to build with her our commitment in Christ by accepting our responsibility as active members in our Parish.

I would like to recognize that the Parish has resumed the Backpack Blessing Program and picked up a 2nd Head Start location; Bible Study has resumed; Contemplative Prayer services continue on Mondays; Second Sunday Supper at St. Barnabas continues; the End of Life program is underway; we have four wonderful choral scholars thanks to the generosity of parishioners; planning on the Memorial Garden is moving forward and there are probably individual efforts that I am missing. I urge the Parish to continue the work of the Church. Let's keep gathering momentum as we move forward!!
